Burning Permits



Burn permits are required by residents. When either the Dallas Township or St. Johns Fire Department responds to a fire, the PROPERTY OWNER is billed.

• Bengal Township residents living West of Francis Road can obtain a burning permit by contacting the Dallas Township Fire Dept. at 989-593-3146. Residents will be asked to leave their name, address, and phone number, what they are burning, and which days they wish to burn. Please call at least 24 hours in advance. If residents have any questions, call Vern Feldpausch, Dallas Township Supervisor, at 989-593-2768.

• Bengal Township residents living East of Francis Road can obtain a burning permit by contacting the City of St. Johns Police Dept. at 989-224-6721. You will be asked your name and address, what you are burning, how much you are burning, and when you wish to burn. It is best to speak with someone to confirm your permit is approved. You are also able to apply for annual burn permits.

Fire and Rescue Runs

In the event of a fire run within the township, \$1,000 is charged when a fire truck is dispatched and/or \$450 when a first responder is dispatched. Bengal Township is charged \$1,000 for the first two hours and \$500 for every hour thereafter for fire service. When Bengal Township gets billed for these services, the property owner and/or person upon whom the service was provided, will be billed. Please check your insurance to see if Fire or First Responder services are covered. Typically, basic home-owners insurance only covers up to \$500. A small increase in your premium could save you money!

Early and Absentee Voting

In November 2022 the voters of Michigan passed Proposal 2022-02 which amended state voting laws. The Michigan Constitution now recognizes that residents, once registered, may submit a onetime single signed absent voter ballot application covering all future elections. Proposal 2022-02 also allows registered voters the option to vote inperson for nine days leading up to election day. This change begins with the 2024 presidential primary. Clinton County is exploring how to best ensure access to early in-person voting for all County residents. Monthly Meeting: The Planning Commission meets on the last Wednesday of each month. Meeting dates as well as cancellation notices are posted on the notification board in front of the hall and on the Township's website.

If you are considering renovations, new construction, or splitting land, you must fill out a Zoning Compliance Application which can be found on the Township's website. Additionally, these actions require ESCROW funding as outlined in the Fee Schedule which can also be found on the Township's website.

Inspections: Please note that all Township projects, including Ag Buildings, must be inspected by the Township Inspector. A preliminary site inspection AND a final inspection is required. If your application is approved, you will receive a letter from the Township's Planning Administrator, McKenna Associates, instructing you to contact Forrest Thurston at 989-640-1890 to set up the inspections. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in fines and project delays.

Hall Rental

The Township Hall is available for rent. Please note that the maximum capacity is 70 people and can be rented by residents for \$100 or non-residents for \$150. A security deposit is also required. Please see the rental agreement and other rental information on the Township's website.
