Discussion Regarding Meeting Minutes from 2-7-18 initiated by Nick McDonald – Original minutes state the following: "The plan of the Bengal Township Planning Commission will be to hold an additional meeting on February 28, 2018 at 7PM with the hope that a representative from McKenna and the township assessor Mark Holley can attend for advisement to the board on what changes would best suit the needs of the township and the residents in relation to the land splits less than 10 acres for existing homesteads on agricultural property."

Mr. Rex Ferguson wanted to know what they should do regarding their proposed land split for Betty Hicks. As it stands now the current ordinance will not allow a split of less than 10 acres. The Commission advised that she can either move forward with a variance request or wait until the Interim Ordinance has addressed the minimum 10 acre requirement.

Commission had in-depth discussion regarding the 10 page Technical Review of Interim Zoning Ordinance dated 12-4-2017 that McKenna completed. Each point was discussed and the Commission will respond to McKenna via marking up the document whether or not they agreed with the recommendations or further clarification or information is needed. McKenna will be at the March 7, 2018 meeting to discuss.
