The Bengal Township Board meeting was brought to order by Supervisor McDonald at 7:00 pm.

The **Pledge of Allegiance** was said and the meeting commenced.

Supervisor McDonald presented the **agenda for approval**, Trustee Boak made a motion to accept the agenda as presented, supported by Treasurer Schultheiss, motion carried.

The **November 10, 2021 meeting minutes** were presented by Clerk Bassette and Treasurer Schultheiss made a motion to accept the minutes as presented, supported by Trustee Boak, motion carried.
