

BENGAL TOWNSHIP BOARD

MEETING 7:00 PM

JUNE 12, 2019

The Bengal Township Board meeting was brought to order by Supervisor Schafer at 7:00 pm.

Members present: Deb Schafer, Nick McDonald, Denice Schultheiss, and Sharon Bassette. Bill Kushmaul absent.

Community present: David Pohl, Larry Paski, and Officer Verlinde

The **Pledge of Allegiance** was said and the meeting commenced.

Supervisor Schafer moved to accept the **agenda** as presented, supported by Clerk Bassette, motion carried.

Trustee McDonald moved to accept the **05/08/19 meeting minutes** as presented, supported by Supervisor Schafer, motion carried.

Treasurer Schultheiss presented the **Treasurer's Report** with handouts. Clerk Bassette made a motion to accept the report as presented, supported by Trustee McDonald, motion carried.

Clerk Bassette presented the **Clerks Report**. Supervisor Schafer moved to accept the clerks report as presented, supported by Trustee McDonald, motion carried.

Clerk Bassette presented the **current bills to be paid**. Treasurer Schultheiss moved to accept the bills as presented, supported by Trustee McDonald, motion carried. Treasurer Schultheiss made a motion to move \$20,000 to the general checking account, Clerk Bassette supported, motion carried.

PUBLIC COMMENT: Larry Paski made comments regarding fire runs.

NEW BUSINESS:

The **Commissioners Report** was given by Dave Pohl. Mr. Pohl discussed 911 funding, the retirement account, jail revenue decline and reasoning, and a possible new park in the southern part of the county similar to Motz Park.

Officer Verlinde gave the **Sheriff's Department Report**. The county is doing well, numbers are low and there has been little crime.

Nick McDonald gave an **update on the Zoning Commission** discussing the last meeting where Christopher from McKenna came to discuss updating the ordinance. Updates were given regarding agriculture zoning requirements, minimum lots size requirements, and ordinance changes.

OLD BUSINESS:

Supervisor Schafer **road work** projects, not much has been done at this point.

Supervisor Schafer talked about the **Ambulance Service**. Due to the 4th Amendment Article changes had to be made to the Ambulance By-Law which needed to have board approval. Treasurer Schultheiss made a motion to accept the changes based on the 4th Amendment requirements, Trustee McDonald supported, motion carried.

Supervisor Schafer discussed changes of work being done by **Cutting Edge**.
